SHARE Annual Report 2019-2020

Every year, the SHARE Center reports the number of contacts received through the telephone, referrals, walk-ins, and electronic communication during the academic year (July through June). By making these reports available, the SHARE Center hopes to encourage all individuals to seek services when they, or someone they know, have experienced sexual misconduct. Note: Due to COVID-19, the vast majority of the Yale community was not on-campus from March 2020-June 2020. During this time, the SHARE Center's physical office was closed and all services were provided remotely by video/phone. The 24/7 hotline continued to operate as usual. In light of these circumstances, the number of new contacts with the center during the last 4 months of the 2019-2020 period captured in this report may have been impacted.
