## SHARE Annual Report 2021-2022

Every year, the SHARE Center reports the initial number of contacts received through the telephone, referrals, walk-ins, and electronic outreach during the academic year (July through June). By making these reports available, the SHARE Center hopes to encourage all individuals to seek services when they, or someone they know, have experienced sexual misconduct. The following annual report captures statistics from July 2021-June 2022. Since the expansion of our operations to include telehealth options beginning on March 2020 due to the COVID-19 pandemic, our staff experienced a change in the profile of the contacts we received with significant increases in the number of individuals staying connected to SHARE for ongoing support and for longer periods of time (including throughout breaks). In response to this new trend, we partnered with colleagues in the Yale Health IT Department to develop a system to track ongoing contacts. We will begin capturing and reporting on this expanded data beginning July 2022 in hopes of providing a richer profile of the utilization of SHARE's services moving forward.
